- 1. Among the candidates considered for shortlisting, those whose sectional and aggregate scores are greater than or equal to the corresponding cut-off scores, as mentioned in the table above, have been given a GD/PI call.
- 2. Apart from the above scenario, following special GD/PI calls have been given:
 - a) Candidates with an aggregate score of 99.9 percentile or higher in CAT 2010. Criteria of sectional scores are relaxed in this scenario.
 - b) Candidates scoring 100 percentile in any of the sections of CAT 2010 have been given calls, provided their aggregate score is 99.66 percentile or higher. Criteria for the remaining sectional scores are relaxed in this scenario.
