

## Short-listing Criteria for IIMA's PGP 2011-13 batch

General Category candidates: 540 candidates whose percentiles in each section were 94 and above, and who had an overall percentile of 99 and had an Application Rating of  $\geq 21$  were considered for personal interview.

NC-OBC Category Candidates: 193 NC-OBC candidates whose percentiles in each section were 84 and above and who had an overall percentile of 94 and an Application Rating of  $\geq 19$  were considered for personal interview.

SC Category Candidates: 108 SC candidates whose percentiles in each section were 75 and above and who had an overall percentile of 80 and an Application Rating of  $\geq 17$  were considered for personal interview.

ST Category Candidates: 55 ST candidates whose percentiles in each section were 50 and above and who had an overall percentile of 80 with an Application Rating of  $\geq 16$  were considered for personal interview.

DA Category Candidates: 21 DA candidates whose percentiles in each section were 65 and above and who had an overall percentile of 80 with an Application Rating of  $\geq 16$  were considered for personal interview.
