

PGP Admission Policy Document of IIM Rohtak for the year 2010

This document details the process that has been developed at Indian Institute of Management Lucknow for the Indian Institute of Management Rohtak (IIMR) for identifying the right candidates for admission to its PGP.

The process that is being adopted for selecting the promising students for PGP at IIMR for the year 2010 involves two stages. Stage-1 applies to all eligible candidates who have appeared for CAT-2009 to determine those qualifying candidates who will be called for Stage-2. Sufficient numbers of candidates belonging to different categories are short listed in Stage-1 for meeting the (Government of India) norms on reservation.

Stage – 1:

All candidates who have secured minimum section – wise and aggregate percentile scores in CAT 2009 are first short listed. The percentile cut-off scores (the minimum percentile scores required) for the Stage-1 consideration are given in Table-1.

Subsequently, seven times the number of candidates required to be admitted will be called for Stage 2 from the top of this list. The number of seats in each category is given in Table 2.

Stage-2:

Stage-2 of the admissions process involves the assessment of the candidate by an interview panel, which will conduct the following:

- (i) Group Discussion (on a given topic for 15 minutes),
- (ii) Personal Interview.

The weights for these components as well as that of CAT are as shown in Table-3.
